## PREFACE

The 2017 Salary Survey is the thirty-second in a series of annual surveys of art museum salaries issued by the Association of Art Museum Directors. The results of this survey represent responses from 219 of 233 museums surveyed—a response rate of 94%.

Among the museums surveyed were both current and former AAMD members. While the response rate of 94% enables this report to be statistically representative of institutions eligible for AAMD membership, one should not assume relevance to museums in other disciplines.

Our thanks are due to Stax Inc., which worked with us to support the effort, and provided analysis and development of insights. Thanks are also due to the museums responding to the survey for the considerable time and effort put into their responses.

The format of the survey reflects metropolitan areas defined as metropolitan statistical areas and micropolitan statistical areas as of July 15, 2015. Maps of metropolitan and micropolitan statistical areas by state are available here. Population data has been updated to reflect 2010 U.S. Census counts.

Canadian and Mexican metropolitan area populations were sourced from Statistics Canada and Instituto Nacional de Estadística y Geografía, respectively.

Salary information is based on compensation for FY16. Salary comparison by designation is not presented for positions if fewer than five museums reported figures for a given designation. Salaries reported by Canadian art museums are reported in Canadian dollars. Commentary on analyzed trends refers to the fiscal year.

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## SURVEY DEFINITIONS

**Income:** Includes an individual’s current base salary, excluding benefits. Incomes have only been reported for full-time employees (i.e. not including independent contractors or consultants). Incomes of support staff not directly employed by the museum haven’t been recorded (e.g. security officers). Incomes of shared service center employees working at academic museums haven’t been recorded.

**Mean:** A measure of central tendency. Indicates the average salary of employees in a group (i.e. if salaries of the entire group were added together and the total was divided by the number of individuals involved). This value is greatly influenced by outliers.

**Median:** A measure of central tendency. It’s the value of the middle item of a group of values when they are arranged from the highest to the lowest. Unlike the mean, this value isn’t greatly influenced by outliers.

**25th Percentile:** A measure of dispersion. When all of the incomes are arranged from the highest to the lowest, the 25th percentile is that income level below which 25% of the incomes fall.

**75th Percentile:** A measure of dispersion. When all of the incomes are arranged from the highest to the lowest, the 75th percentile is that income level below which 75% of the incomes fall.

**Year over year (YOY) Growth:** A measure of growth. It measures growth between two identical periods and compares the results of one period with that of another comparable time period— on an annualized basis.

**Compounded Annual Growth Rate (CAGR):** A measure of growth. It’s the mean (geometric) annual growth rate of salaries taking into account multiple periods. It’s calculated by considering the beginning and ending values of a data set. Unlike a YOY growth, CAGR considers the compounding values (i.e. takes into account salary increments and cuts overtime).

$$CAGR = \left( \frac{\textit{Final Value}}{\textit{Starting Value}} \right)^{\frac{1}{N}} - 1$$

## KEY INSIGHTS AND TAKEAWAYS

As part of this 2017 salary survey, we at the Association of Art Museum Directors (AAMD) collaborated with our consulting partner, Stax Inc., to increase the level of analysis and insights in this report. The 2017 AAMD salary survey had a response rate of 94%—compared to 92% the previous year—and received responses from 219 museums across North America.

### High Level Insights—Salaries

The results from this salary survey affirm the value of quality staff for museums. Human resource needs consistently make up a significant portion of an art museum's operating budget. Nearly two-thirds (64%) of responding museums stated that they spent between 41%–60% of their operating budget on payroll-related expenses, which is up from 57% in FY 2015.

Growth in average salary levels has mirrored the rate of economic growth in the country—growing at an average annual rate of 2%–3% over the past six years. In 2016, the average median salary increased 3%, while in the preceding year it grew at a rate of 2.7%.

There are a few designations that have seen higher salary growth, highlighting changes in the industry and changing needs of museums:

- Between 2011–2016, Chief Operating Officers (COOs) experienced salary growth at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 5.5%—about double the average rate across other museum positions:
  - This may reflect the increasing complexity of museum operations, which demands more skills and experience in the COO role.
  - COOs also tend to be employed by larger museums: 60% of COOs are employed by museums with an operating budget in excess of \$10 million.
- Between 2011–2016, curatorial staff saw the second fastest growth in salaries, with average median incomes growing at a rate of over 4.6%:
  - The Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) listed curators as highly in-demand professionals during the past 8–9 years, which may account for the strength of these positions in commanding salary increases.
  - However, the BLS also estimates the number of curators to grow by 8% in the period between 2014–2024.

## KEY INSIGHTS AND TAKEAWAYS

- Positions related to information services or online content management also experienced growth in average salaries—likely reflecting the ongoing work by museums to build their social media and web presence and seek new opportunities to use digital tools to cultivate audiences:
  - For example, those in the job of Director of New Media experienced a 3.1% increase (Year-over-Year) in salary, on average, between 2015 and 2016.
- Between 2015–2016, museum directors experienced a 1.6% growth in median salaries—below the 3% average of all staff positions in the survey:

### High Level Insights—Benefits

- For non-director level employees, there was a considerable rise in Paid Time Off (PTO): the percentage of employees with tenure of less than 1 year being offered 2 weeks of PTO increased from 26% in 2012 to 63% in 2015:
  - This trend likely reflects a recognition that millennials and younger employees highly value time off, making this an important benefit and necessary to remain competitive in hiring.
- 48% of museums offered non-director level executive staff reimbursements for acquiring or maintaining professional licenses—while only 42% of museums offered such benefits to director level staff.
- Meanwhile, directors are more likely to receive vehicle or housing allowances—indicative of the fact that higher level positions are often filled at the national level, requiring director level staff to relocate.

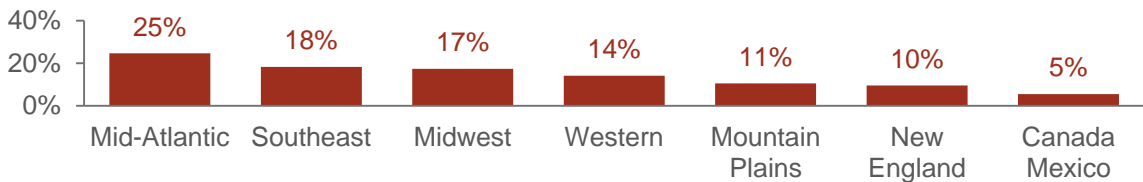

### *Distribution of Museums by AAM Region*

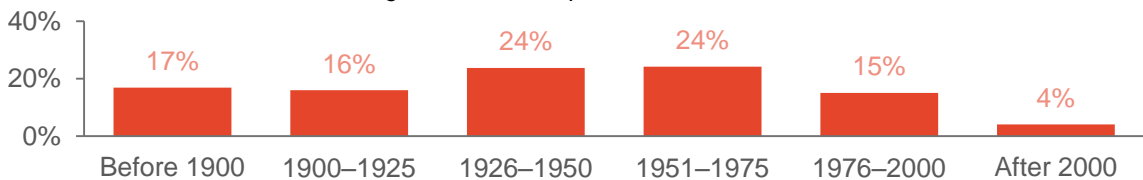

### *Distribution of Museums by Founding Date*

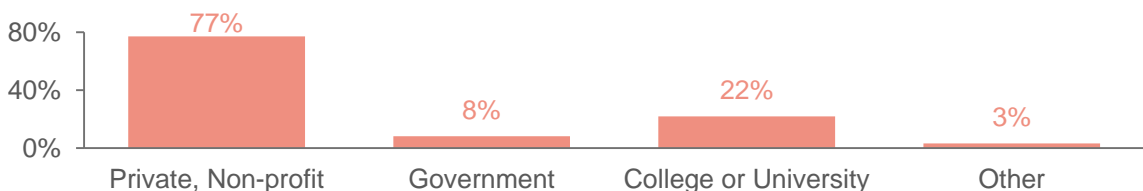

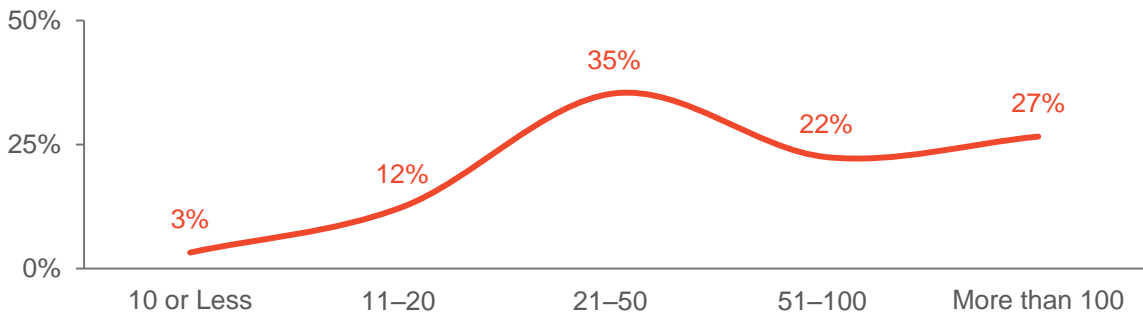

### **Distribution of Museums by the Number of Full Time Employees**

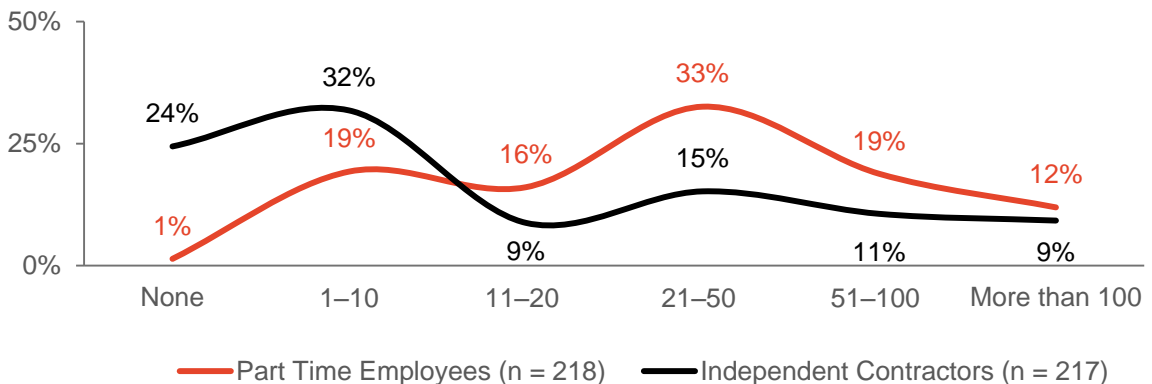

### **Distribution of Museums by Employee Type**

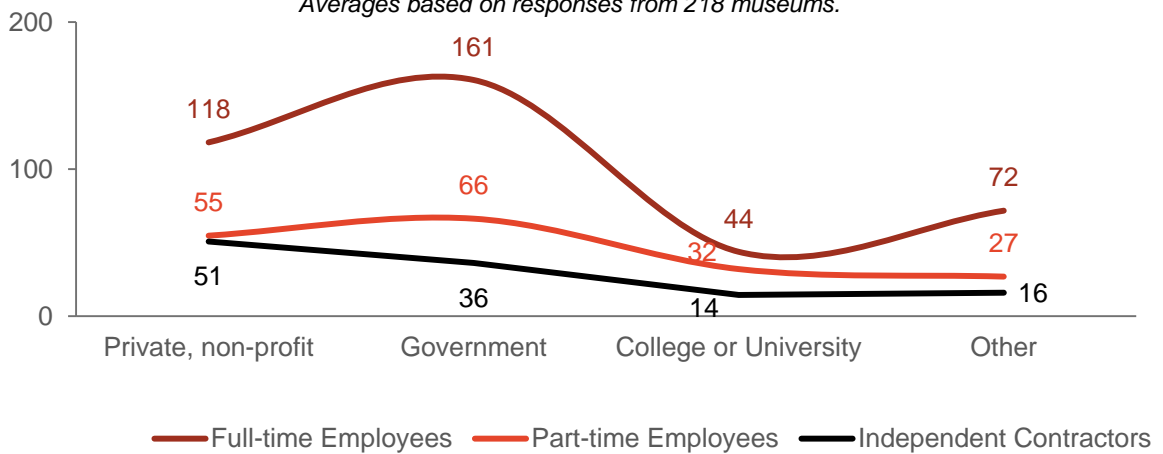

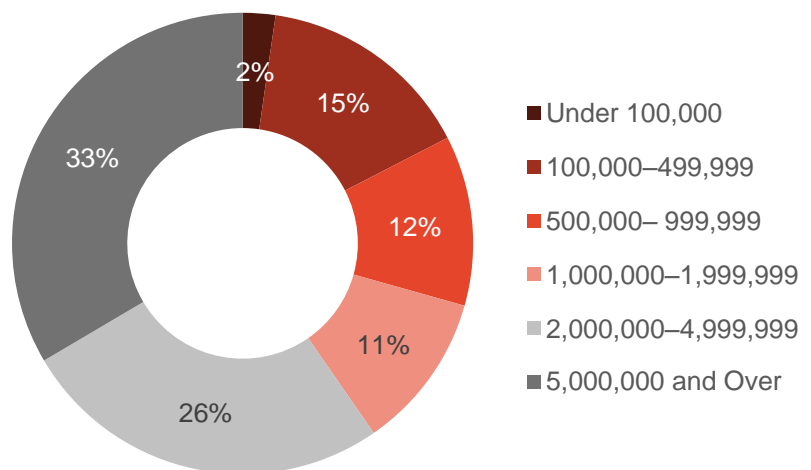
### Average Number of Full Time, Part Time, and Independent Contractors by Governance Patterns

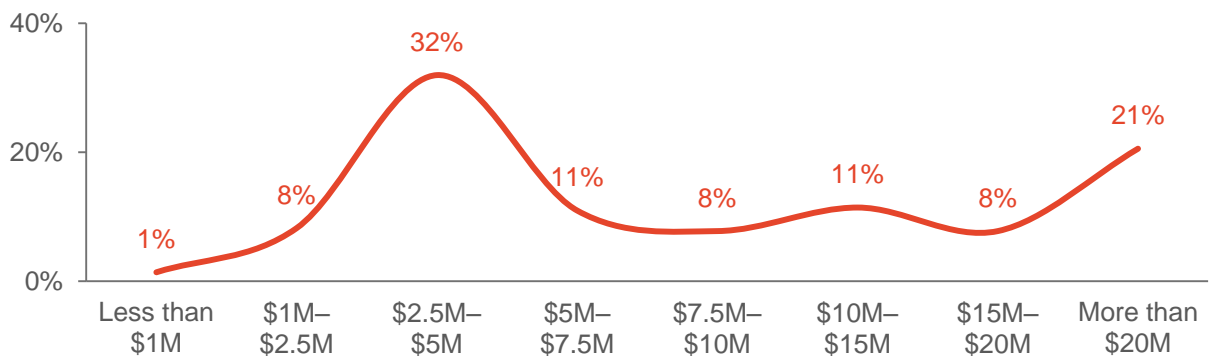

## FISCAL CHARACTERISTICS OF RESPONDING MUSEUMS

Of 219 museums surveyed, almost 60% commenced their fiscal year in July, with a further 20% starting at the beginning of the calendar year and another 10% in October.

### **Distribution of Museums by Annual Operating Budget**

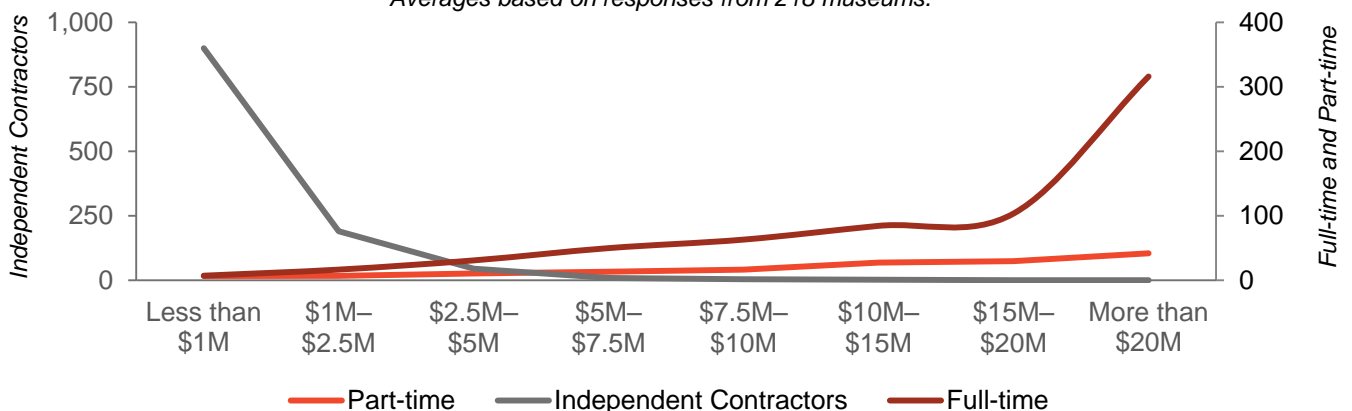

Of the museums surveyed, there was an upward trend in the size of the operating budget— with the number of museums in the top bracket (more than \$20M) growing from 37 in 2015 to 45 by 2016, an increase (YoY) of 22%. Moreover, 18 of the museums had an operating budget of over \$50M, of which 6 had a budget over \$100M.

### **The Average Number of Full-time Employees by the Size of the Annual Operating Budget**

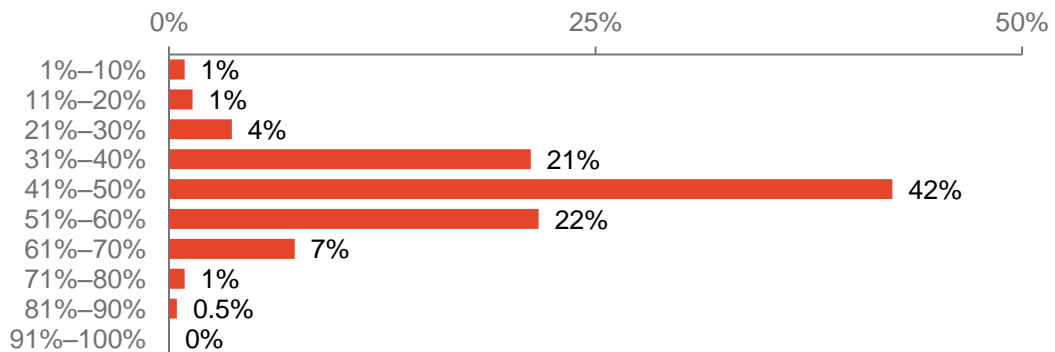

### *Distribution of Museums by Payroll as a Percentage of Total Budget*

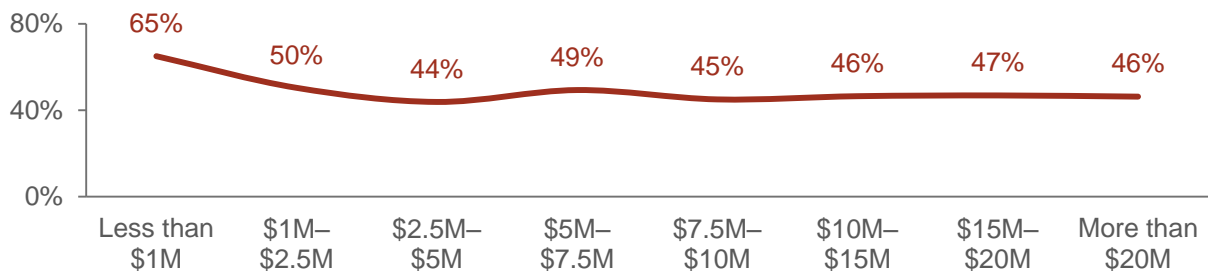

The number of museums spending over 50% of their budget on payroll expenses increased from 55 in 2015 to 66 by 2016— an increase (YoY) of 20%.

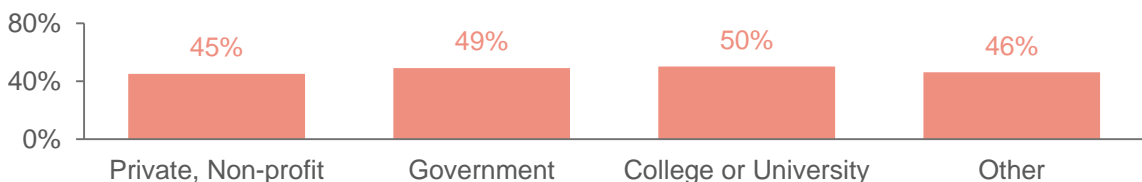
### *Payroll Expenditure as a Percentage of the Annual Operating Budget by Size*

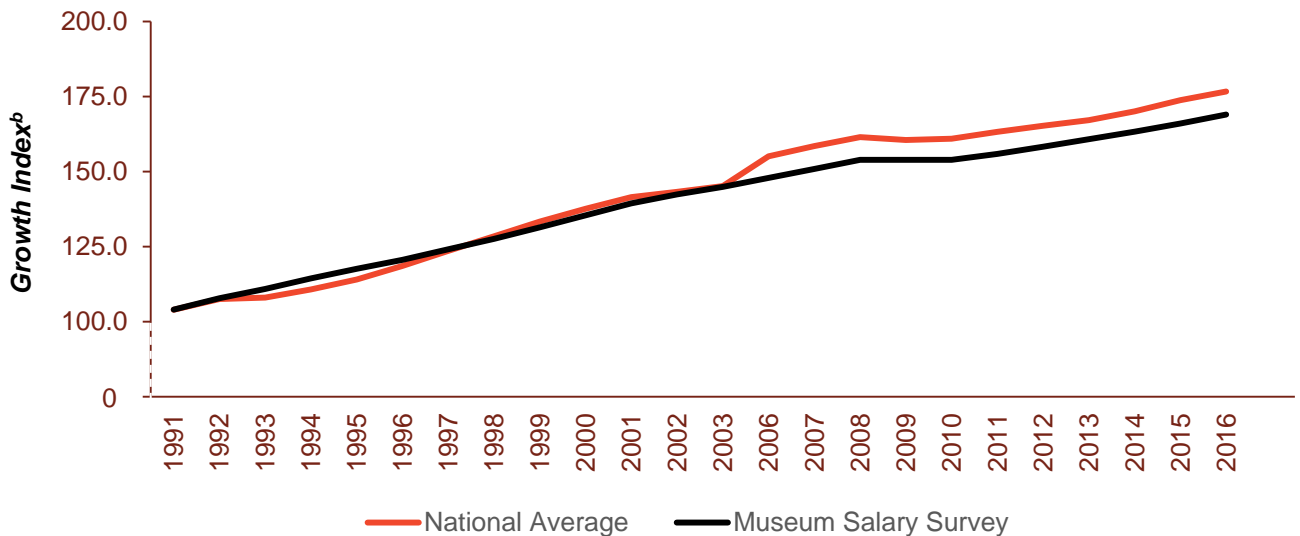

## SALARY PROCEDURES OF RESPONDING MUSEUMS

*NOTE<sup>a</sup>: The median national average salary increase is based on the National Average Wage Index (NAWI)—an index calculated annually by the Social Security Administration (SSA) based on wages subject to federal income taxes and contributions. 2016 figures are based on estimates provided by the SSA's Trustees Report.*

*Even though the median increase in salaries of the AAMD survey grew at a slower pace than the national average in the period between 1991-2016, it's worth noting that in 2016 the average median salary as per the AAMD survey stood at \$63,543 (based on the median salary weighted by FTE's), while the national average wage index was reported at \$49,493— almost 22% lower.*

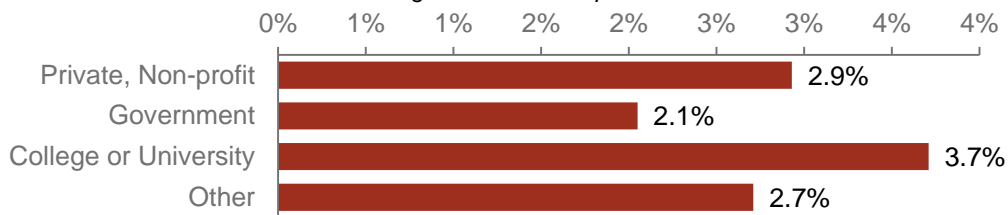

### Average Increase in Salaries During the Last Fiscal Year by Type of Institution (i.e., type of governance)

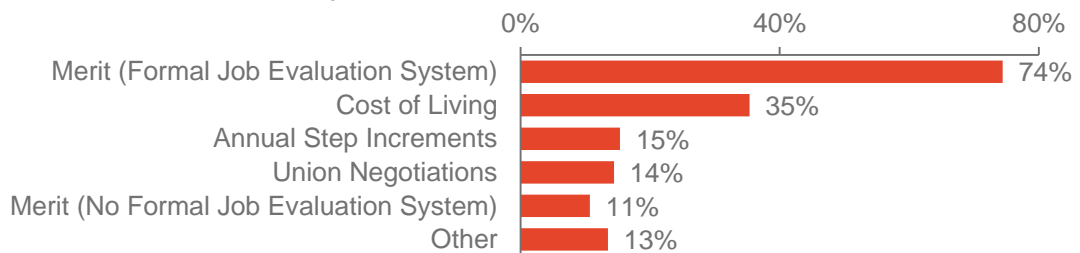

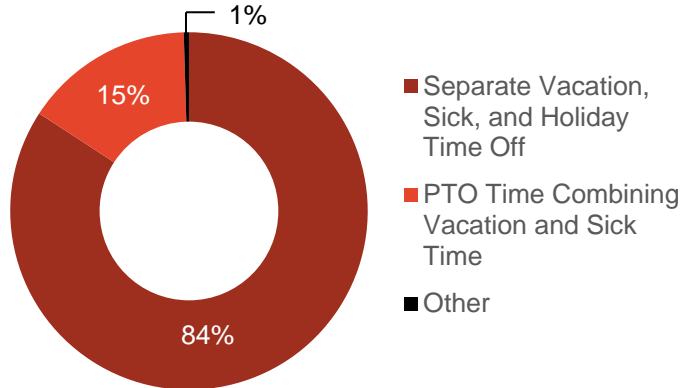

### Distribution of Museums by Vacation, Sick and Holiday Time Off Offering Policy

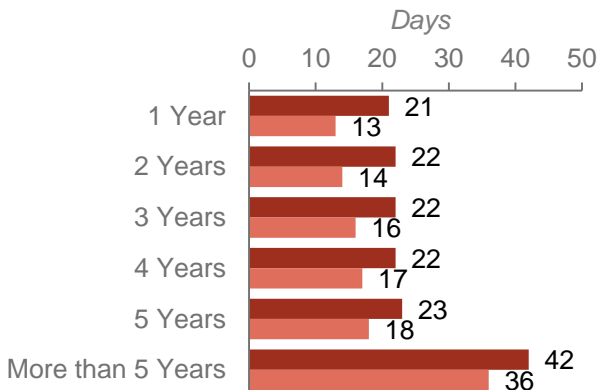

When offered at different rates for Exempt and Non-exempt Employees.

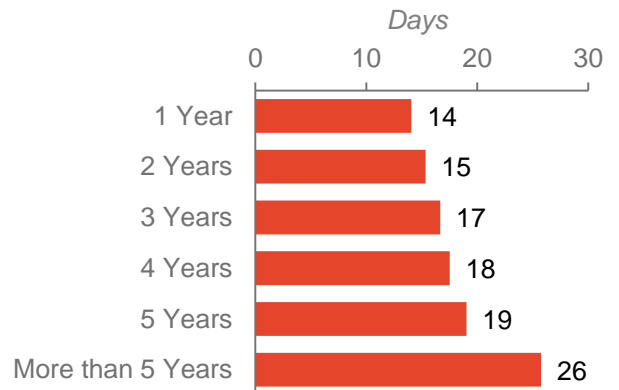

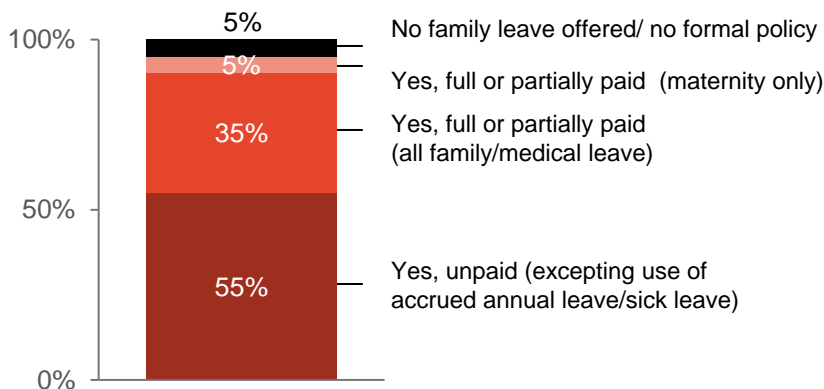
## EMPLOYEE BENEFITS OF RESPONDING MUSEUMS

Approximately 84% of responding museums allowed earned vacation/PTO days that are not used during the current fiscal year to be carried forward to the next. The number of days allowed to be carried over varied from as low as 5 to as much as 80 in certain instances.

On average, museums offer regular full-time employees 12 sick days and 4 personal/ floating holidays per year.

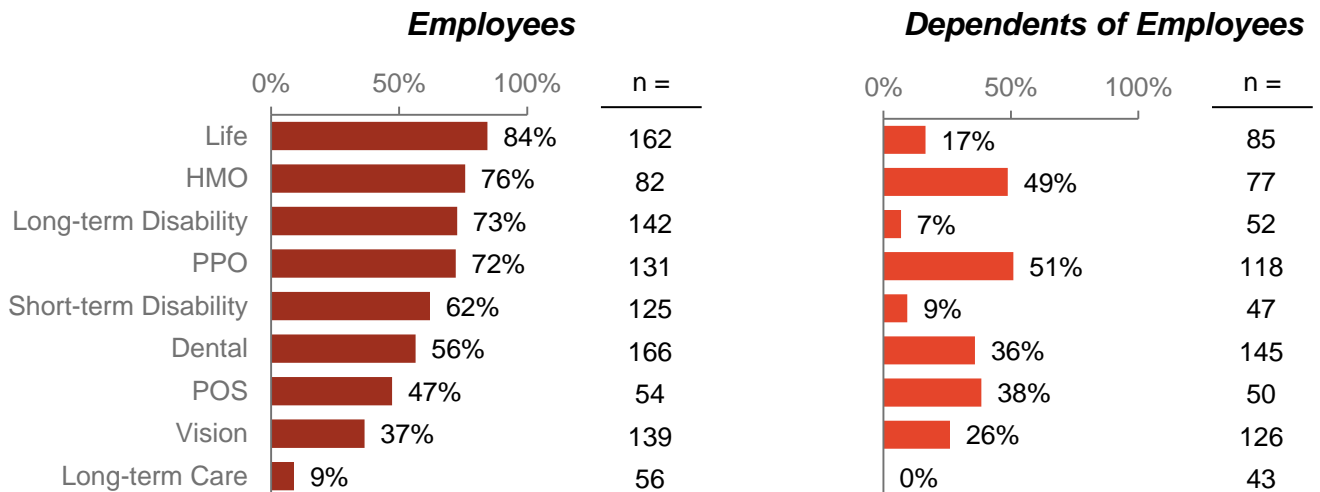

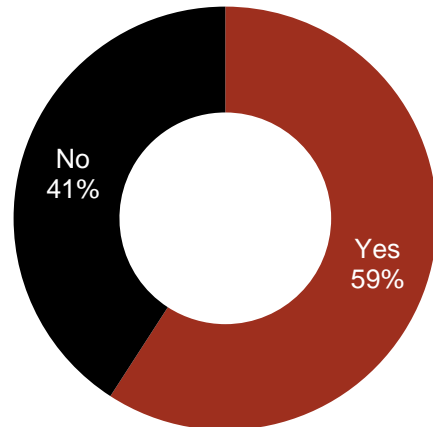

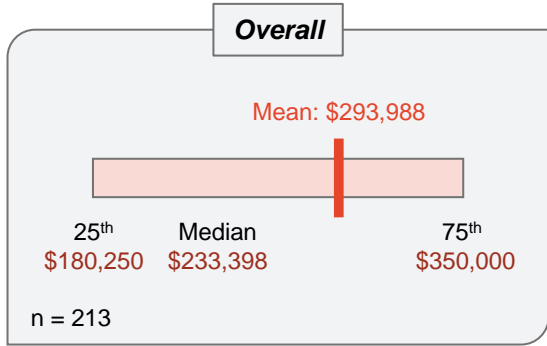

**Historical Trend—Median (2011–2016)**

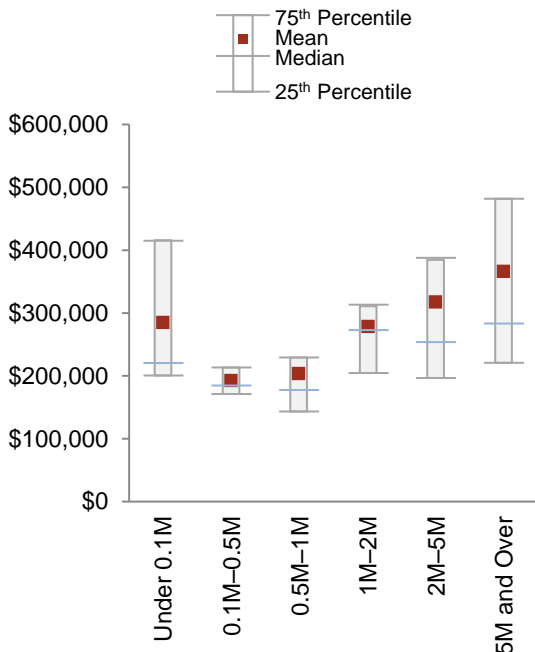

**Historical Trend—Median (2011–2016)**

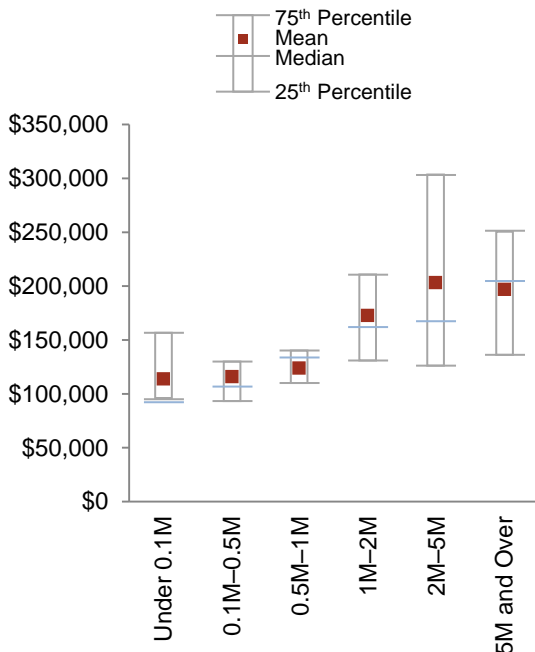

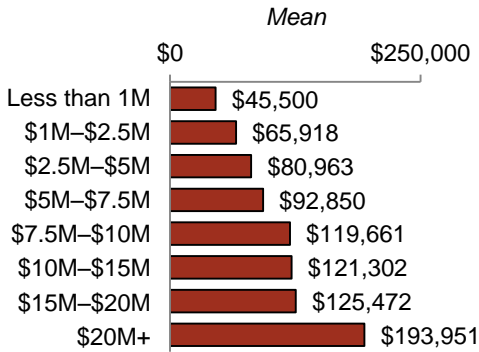
